We have a "special FUN committee" to plan games and activities for our younger and not-so-young parishioners.

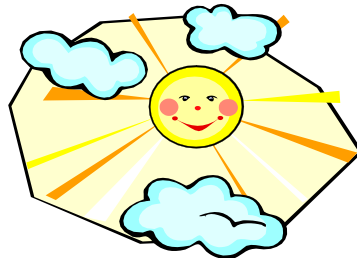


RSVP
