This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. This event marks the beginning of Jesus' public ministry and reveals to us profound truths about His identity and mission. In the form of a dove, the Holy Spirit descends upon Him which signifies God's approval for Jesus and what He will do for us.

By stepping into the waters of the Jordan Jesus shows His humility and His deep solidarity with humanity. This act foreshadows His ultimate mission: to take upon Himself the sins of the world and bring about our redemption through His death and resurrection.

The Baptism of Jesus is also a profound moment of revelation. As He comes up from the water, the heavens open, the Spirit descends like a dove, and the voice of the Father declares, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased". Here we see the Trinity revealed- the Father's voice, the Son in the waters of Jordan, and the Spirit descending.

This feast reminds us of our own baptism. Through baptism, we are united with Christ, cleansed of sin, and marked as God's beloved children. It is the foundation of our Christian life, calling us to live in a way that reflects our dignity and mission as members of God's family.

The Baptism of the Lord challenges us to follow His example of humility. We are called to humble ourselves to serve those who are marginalized, suffering, or in need. Our baptism calls us to be people of compassion, justice, and love.

Finally, this feast invites us to open our hearts to the Holy Spirit. At Jesus' baptism, the Spirit descended upon Him, empowering Him for His mission. In the same way, the Spirit is given to us at baptism, equipping us to live as disciples and witnesses of Christ in the world.

As we reflect on the Baptism of the Lord, let us renew our commitment to live out our baptismal promises. May the Spirit guide us and strengthen us to walk in the footsteps of Jesus, bringing His light and hope to a world in need.

June 4 - 7, 2025


Our Parish Garage Sale will take place once again this spring. We will need both volunteers and donations, so if you are doing Spring cleaning, keep the garage sale in mind.
